Eaton Visits Castro, Accepts Bid to Cuba

NEW YORK — UPD — Cleveland millionaire Cyrus Eaton visited Fidel Castro today. Eaton reported that the Cuban president's fondest wish is for a return to normal relations with the United States.

The 76-year-old capitalist, busier than many a UN delegate at the current "summit" session, emerged from a 30-minute private conference with Castro at Harlem's Hotel Theresa and announced that

Castro had invited him and Mrs. Eaton to visit Cuba and they had accepted.

"He (Castro) is a man of great energy, great ambition and real devotion to helping his people," Eaton said.

Eaton, who entertained Khrushchev and other prominent Russians at a private luncheon on Monday, will throw a private dinner for Czechoslovakian President Antonin Novotny tonight at the Hotel Diltmore.
