

STEPS TO PEACE:

1. A candid examination of ourselves in order to disclose our limitations and weaknesses as contrasted to the nobility and perfection which we have been claiming.
2. A repeal of the declaration of cold war and an announcement to the world that our policy is not to wage war but to preserve peace. This involves a complete change in our foreign policy and will require a radical change in personnel in both the State Department and in the United Nations.
3. We must realize that our military policy as well as our foreign policy are obsolete. We must substitute scientific knowledge and technical skills for the "squad's right" conventional military training.
4. End the crushing burden of taxation.
