Patricia Lindop (1930-2018) was a professor of radiation biology at the University of London. She was the organiser of at least 100 meetings where scientist discussed their nuclear disarmament campaign.

She studied medicine at St Bartholomew's Hospital Medical College as one of the first ever female students allowed. For a period, she worked as a general practitioner, before starting to conduct research on the effects of radiation on the body and publishing more than 40 papers on the subject. She was an important member and organiser of the Pugwash movement, which brought together scientists who opposed nuclear weapons.
