Eaton Genealogy - written by Arthur Wentworth Hamilton
Eaton in 1885 and revised by him in 1929.

There were some Eatons who moved from Nova ~~SCOTIA~~ Scotia
to Auckland N.Z. around 1860. The following information
deals with these Eatons.

Levi Woodworth (8) Eaton, son of Amos (7) and Sarah (Harris)
Eaton, married (1) Sarah Bigelow.

Moved to Auckland N.Z. 1860 with his son Capt. George
Eaton, and was a merchant there, his wife died in 1878 and
he married a second time.

Capt. George and wife had a son Reobert Crane Eaton
who remained in Auckland with his grandfather. Levi and
wife had the following children:

- 1) Sarah Jane, B 12.11.1835, married in n.z. and in 1885 had eight children
- ii) Lydia Ann b...? married in n.z. to Capt. John James and in 1885 had 9 children
- iii) George Woodworth born? married in Nova Scotia Mary Anne Crane, They had 2 children - a daughter who died young, and a son Robert Crane who lived with his grandfather Eaton in Auckland
- iiii) Albert (Woodworth) born (1868?) had children (Janet, Jessie, Drum, Fred)

ALPHEUS (8) Eaton, son of Amos and ~~Sarah~~ Sarah (Harris) Eaton born 1 Sep. 1831, married in N.Z. He went to California in 1859 and then to N.Z. Shortly after his brother Levi Woodworth Eaton moved there. He became a merchant in Auckland. Amelia Eaton born 12.1.1835 married 1.1.1857. to Albert Porter, son of Pingree Porter, and lived in Auckland.

They had 4 sons.
