Dear Mr. Eaton,

Pugwash Conference on "Disarmament and World Security"

As you know it became necessary to postpone the above Conference, scheduled for September 11th to 18th in Moscow. The new date for the Conference is November 27th to December 5th and I am writing to invite you and Mrs. Eaton again to attend the meeting. I apologise for the inconvenience caused by the postponement and I hope that you will find the new date convenient. Our Soviet colleagues tell us that the weather in Moscow is quite reasonable at this time of the year.

The Pugwash Continuing Committee hope to arrange another Conference devoted to the same topic, to be held in the United States, probably during the summer of 1961. An announcement about this will be made at the same time as the Moscow Conference is announced.

In this connection I have been asked to point out to all participants and guests that the procedure concerning publicity used at previous Pugwash Conferences will be adopted for the forthcoming Moscow meeting. This means that communications to the press relating to the Conference can be made only by the Committee, with the explicit agreement of the participants of the Conference. Individual authors are at liberty to publish the contents of their papers, but publications from the Conference itself, or describing its proceedings, will only be made by general agreement.

I am looking forward to hearing from you that you will be able to come.
